Frequently Asked Questions For Parents

My Scout has not skied before, or is a beginning skier – is it OK if he goes on the trip?

- Parents are responsible in assessing their son's ability to ski and participate in this trip
- Stratton Mountain is a large ski facility with many challenging ski runs
- If your son has not skied previously or is new to skiing i.e. has difficulty skiing down the mountain on their own, a parent must attend the trip to accompany the Scout

As a parent, I would like to attend the trip, but I don't ski, do I need to pay the same price?

• For parents attending the trip, but not skiing, we will discount the cost to \$110.00 for adults actively participating / volunteering in the troop and \$180.00 for other adults

Are Scout's sibling allowed to attend the ski trip?

• Siblings are not eligible for the Ski Trip. Troop 76 Scouts need to qualify to attend the trip i.e. selling minimum wreath sales commitment and participate in six service hour – four of which must be Troop-sponsored.

My son would like to take lessons at Stratton – how do I arrange it?

- Contact Stratton Mountain to arrange for lessons: 1-800-STRATTON
- Scouts will be escorted to and from the ski lesson area at Stratton for the lesson by adult leaders

My son would like to ski in the Terrain Park – are there special arrangements that I need to make?

- Scouts that intend to use the Terrain Park, must take the Stratton Safety Education Session available online at <u>www.stratton.com/sesonline</u>
- All terrain park users are required to watch an online video, take and pass the quiz, and bring the 5-digit code they receive at the end of the quiz to the Sales Center in the Main Base Lodge to obtain their SES Pass

How can I communicate to the Troop during the trip?

- Cell phone service at Stratton has historically be very spotty depending on where an individual is at the mountain, they may or may not have cell phone service
